The 65 Trial

The 65 Trial is a randomised clinical trial to evaluate the clinical and cost-effectiveness of permissive hypotension (a mean arterial pressure target of 60 – 65 mmHg whilst receiving vasopressors) in patients aged 65 years or over with vasodilatory hypotension. To ensure efficiency in design, the trial is nested within the CMP and therefore benefits from the high quality CMP data already collected. The 65 Trial is being carried out in 65 CMP participating units and more information can be found on our [website](#)
