Critical care units in the Case Mix Programme

Between 1 April 2014 and 31 March 2015, there were a total of 241 NHS adult critical care units in England, Wales and Northern Ireland participating in the Case Mix Programme with at least six months' validated data.

The breakdown of units and admissions by unit type is shown below:

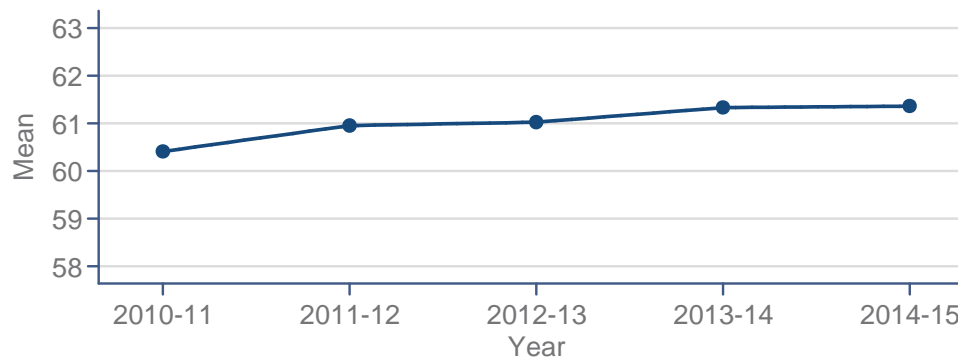

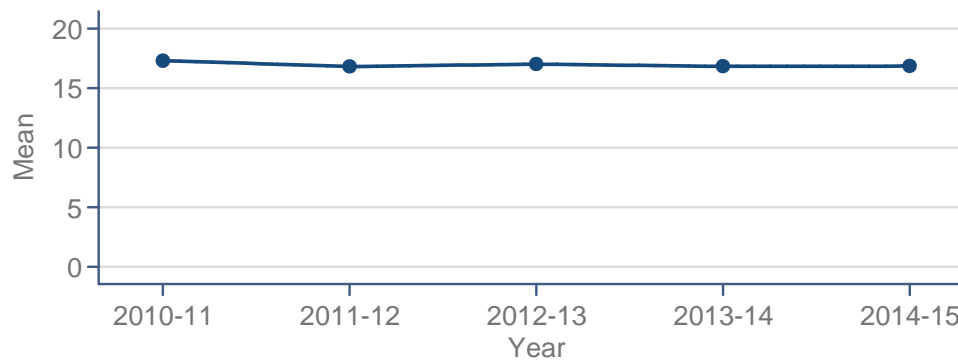
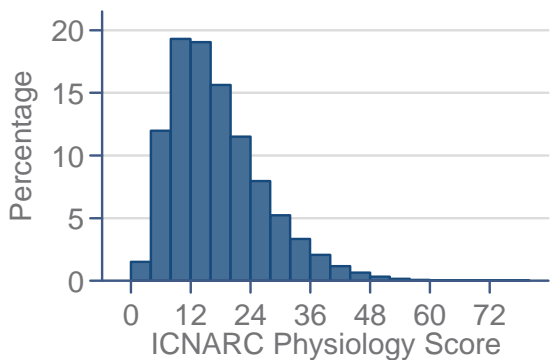

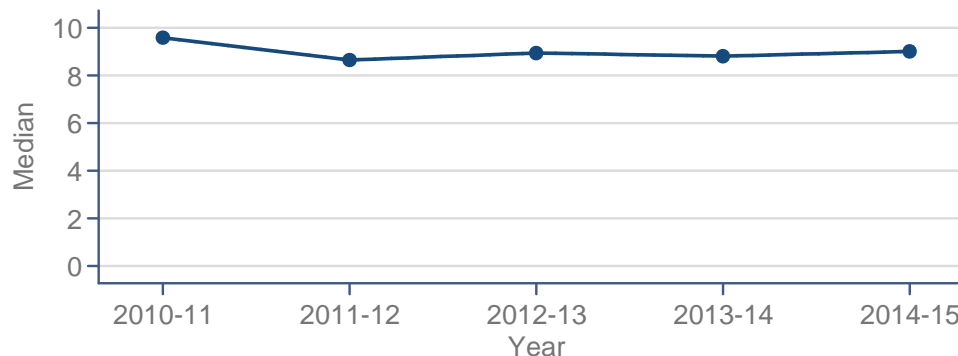
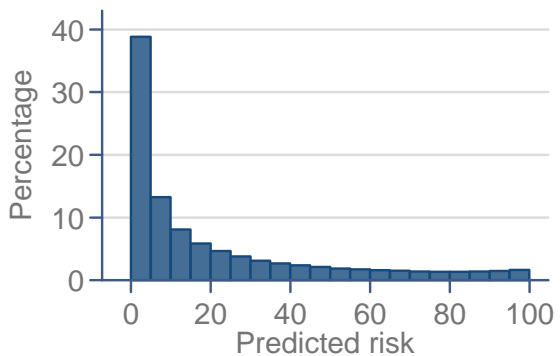

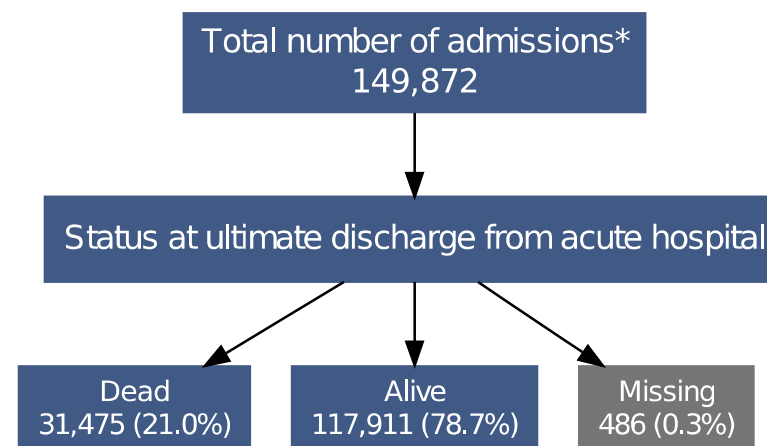
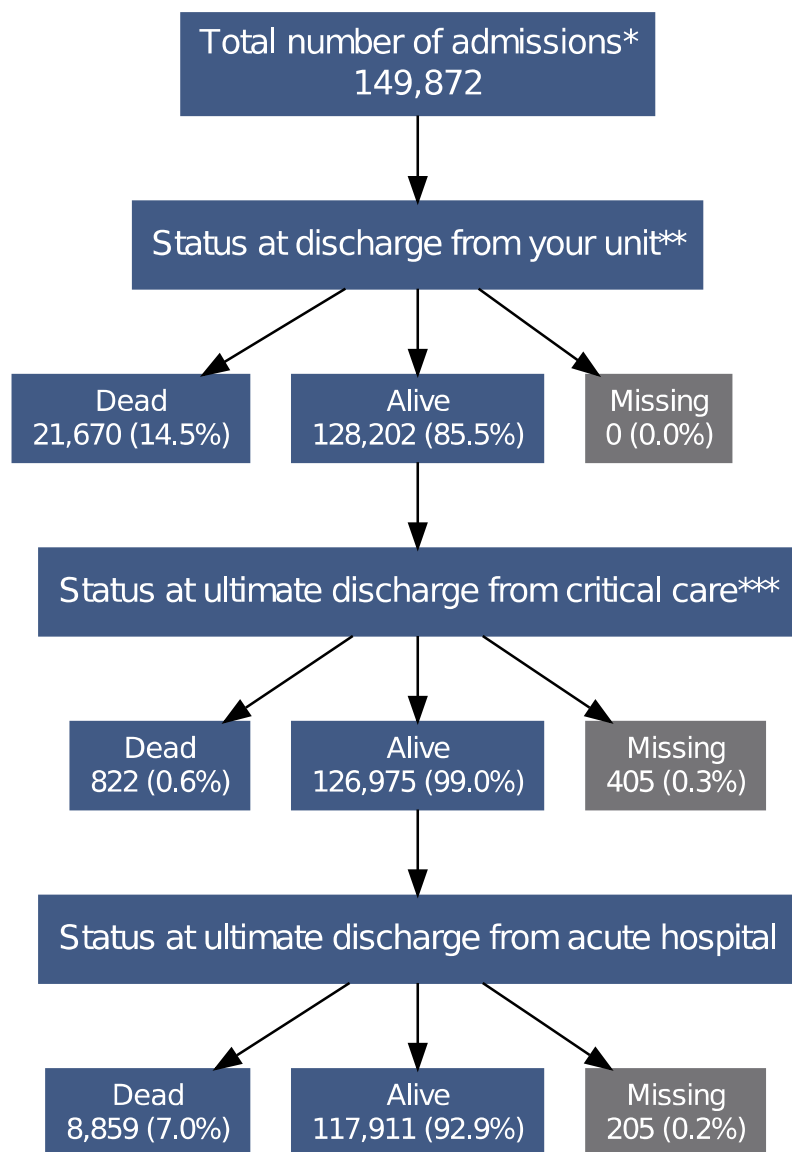
ICNARC Physiology Score

Explanation

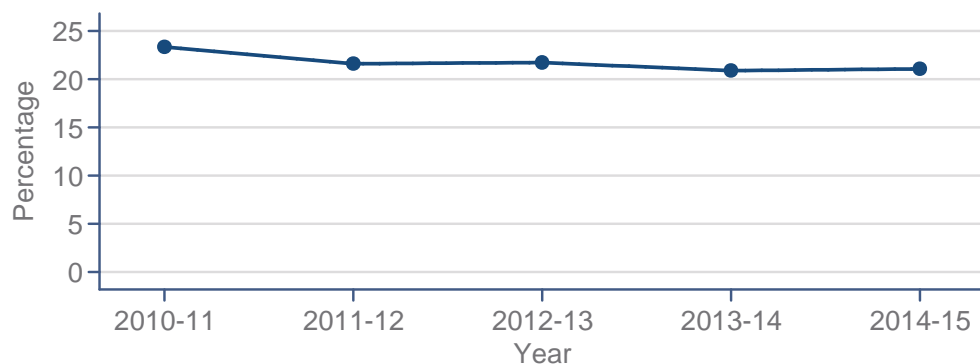
- In the staged outcome flow (left), the numbers of admissions at each stage are reported as percentages of those alive at the previous stage
- In the overall outcome flow (above), the status at ultimate discharge from acute hospital is presented as the percentage of all acute hospital admissions (i.e. excluding readmissions of the same patient in the same acute hospital stay)

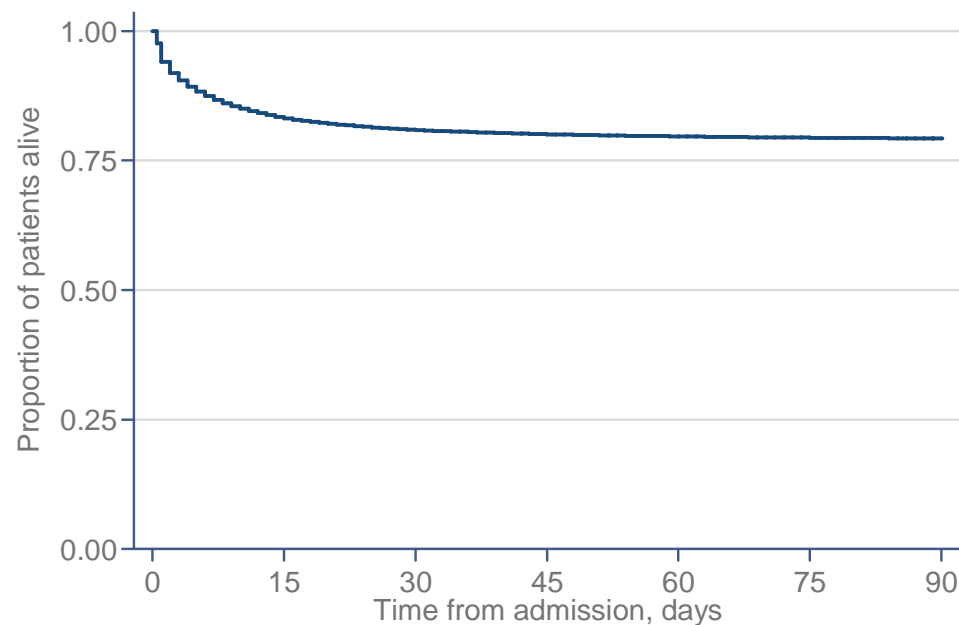
Critical care unit mortality*

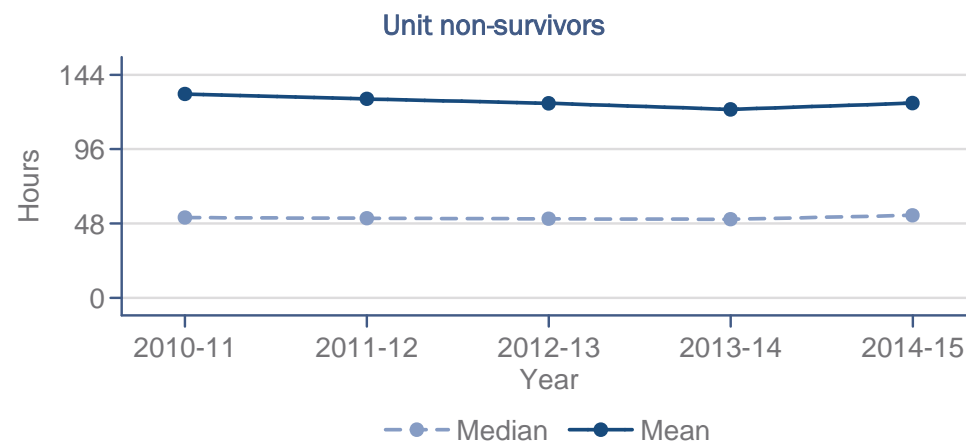
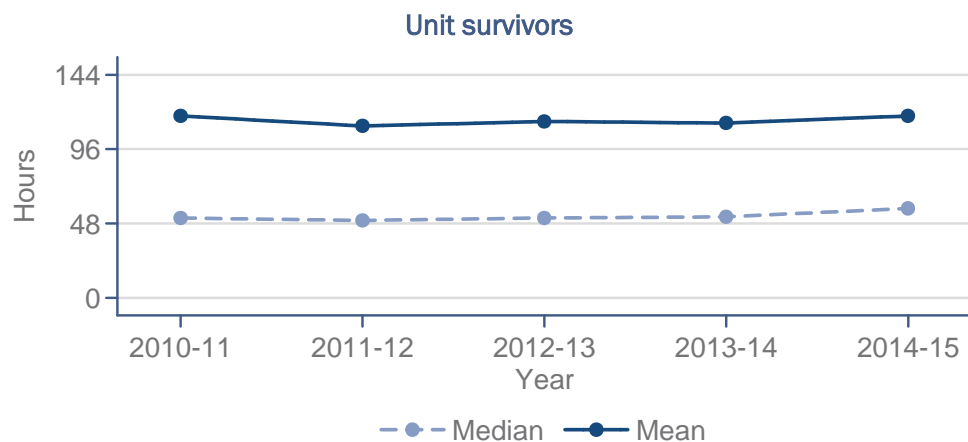

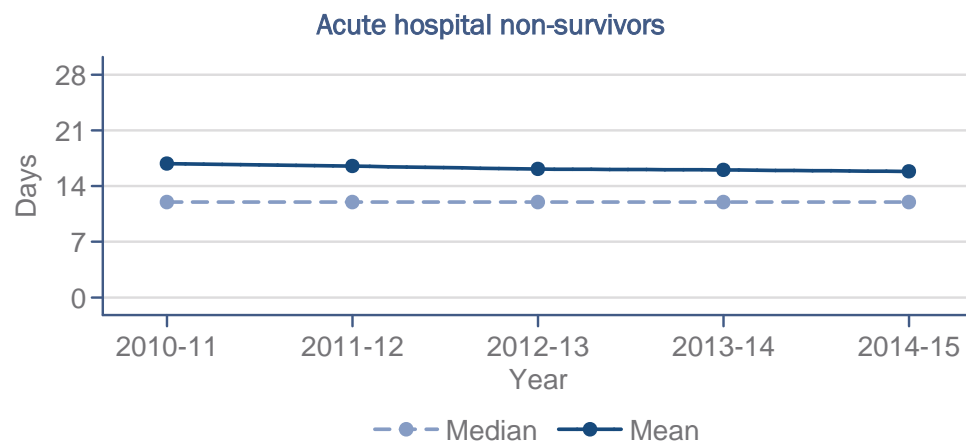
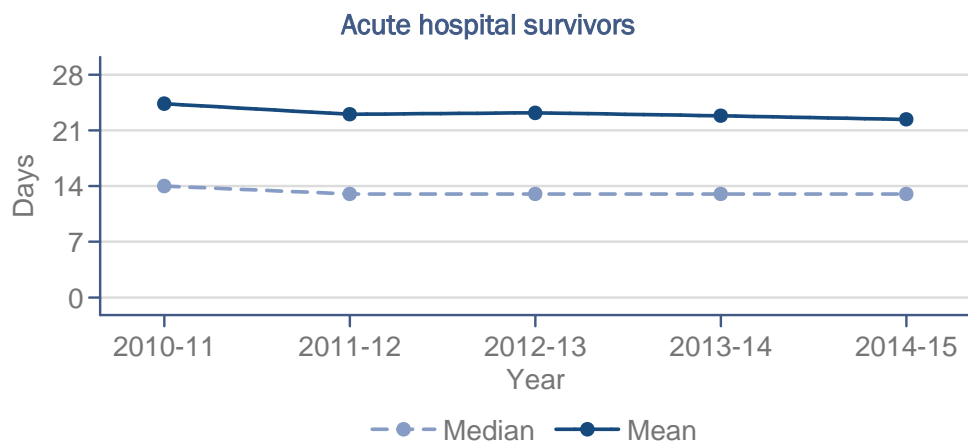
